## NEW SESSION FORMATS

### **PED** Perio Talks – 1st EFP Graduate-Alumni-Symposium

These talks will be based on the general topic „Periodontal Experience and Discoveries worth spreading“. Selected speakers will have the opportunity to present a 10 to 12 minute talk on experiences that have significantly inspired their professional career.



### **Nightmare session**

Master clinicians will present some of their most horrible treatment scenarios. They will explain how they could have been avoided, how they could be rescued and what we can learn from (their) mistakes.



### **Debate**

The use of systemic antibiotics in periodontology will be passionately discussed by top experts in light of the emerging threat of worldwide antibacterial resistance.



### **Live Surgery Periodontal/Peri-implant Plastic Surgery**

A top surgical team will perform live procedure(s) in plastic surgery and entertain questions.



### **Treatment Planning – Interactive Session**

Complex treatment planning scenarios will be presented and then possible treatment decisions and solutions discussed by an interdisciplinary team of experts. This is followed by audience voting before the final outcomes will be revealed.



### **3D-Session**

In a movie-theatre type auditorium, top experts will display 3-D films on regenerative/reconstructive procedures in advanced periodontal/peri-implant defects including follow-up documentation.



### **EFP Perio Contest**

Various cases will be submitted and a pre-selection made by a Jury of world renowned experts. Via Social Media Voting, the top 3 cases will be selected to be presented at EuroPerio9. The overall winner will then be chosen via live voting in Amsterdam.
